## CONTROLLED MEDICATION SUBSTANCES

### Regulation

- At the end of the expertise, two stallions will be randomly selected for a anti-doping control.
- A veterinary, nominated by the Studbook, will collect the biologic samples (urine – blood).
- These samples will be analyzed in a recognized laboratory for control the use of prohibited substances.
- The presence of prohibited substances is determining for the cancelation of the approval.
- The list of prohibited substances determined in the FEI regulations is applied.
- Two stallions will be randomly selected after the final test for loose jumping.
- Those stallions will immediately be escorted to a specific box, where the veterinary will collect the urine and blood samples.
- A delay period of thirty minutes will be respected for the collection of urine.
- The stallion owner cannot refuse to submit his stallion for this sample collection.
